Overview

The knowledges a community has access to explains its successes and failures, and defines its future. Yet for many communities' access to knowledge remains defined by outsiders. The academy is both an inqulobane-repository of knowledges required for building thriving and sustainable communities and also a tool for the exclusion of some identities from knowing. In the face of exclusion, the answer is not an inclusion which has hitherto been contingent on people giving up (at least in part) their identity and never receiving full acceptance by the dominant outsider community.

A discussion is due on the role of power, language, identity and kujichagulia in relation to knowledges in curriculum, disciplines, and the academy. Kujichagulia encompasses the right of the continent to determine its future by building identities that can both khusela-defend and build sustainable platforms for economic participation.
